

- The cognitive-specificity hypothesis states that each mental health condition has distinct dysfunctional beliefs and thought patterns.
 - Pinpointing specific cognitive patterns in OCD is complicated by the diverse range of obsessions and themes.
 - The two factor model is more of a psychoanalytic than cognitive model that fails to provide a specific cognitive account fo OCD.
